

# DESTINATIONS INT'L TRAINING TRACK OUTLINE

## **I. Phase I**

### **A. Identify:**

- Where DNI stands doctrinally and practically, and your personal willingness to serve with them (click here to read what we believe).
- the type of assignment: short/long term; church planting/mercy ministry; lead/support role.

### **B. Clarify:**

- Pastor's approval to go forward in the application
- Country/region/people group/religion of interest

### **C. Gather Info:**

Fill out the "DNI Application Form" (information about your life experience, formal/non-formal studies, cross-cultural experience, ministry experience, work experience/skills, etc.)

## **II. Phase II**

### **Establish:**

- A. -Home church involvement: meet and share with leadership team; request assignments/training; discuss support needs
- B. -Choose a mentor in the home church
- C. -Contact the DNI "Guidance Counselor" and determine frequency of check-in
- D. -Set an approximate length of preparation period before departure for service: for Short-Term (less than 2 years) normally 4 months; for Long-Term (3+ years) normally 12 months minimum
- E. -Recruit prayer partners
- F. -Assemble a local "support team"
- G. -Acceptance by DNI in consultation with local church leaders

### **III. Phase III**

#### **Design:**

- A. Missionary Preparation Chart for personal use locally (Track I and perhaps Track II)
- B. Ministry assignments and reports
- C. Guided reading assignments and reports
- D. Character evaluation and formation (Gal. 5:22,23; I Tim. 3:2-7; Titus 1:6-9)
- E. Personality evaluation: strengths and weaknesses
- F. Relationship skills and formation
- G. Theological training (reading, reports and discussions):
- H. Theology Proper
- I. Anabaptist History and Theology
- J. Apologetics
- K. Religion specific (research, report and encounter)
- L. On-the-job training
- M. Practical skills training modules
- N. Study at EBI (one or more terms recommended, especially 2nd and 3rd terms; DNI provides tuition for approved workers)
- O. Long Term Orientation at the Mission Training Center (required for all candidates before departure)

### **IV. Phase IV**

#### **Evaluate:**

- A. Meeting of pastor, mission committee, mentor, Guidance Counselor, DNI Board member for review and evaluation of readiness
- B. Meet with DNI board (or sub-committee) for assignment, or...
- C. Acquire additional preparation and/or...
- D. Proposal for continuing education during the first term on field with subsequent review.
